

HIGH SCHOOL BOWLER OF THE YEAR NOMINATION FORM



The Treasure Coast USBC is proud to provide financial assistance through scholarship awards to multiple high school college bound **Juniors or Seniors**. These scholarship offerings will be awarded to selected youth players who have contributed not only to the game of bowling but have also contributed dedicated services involving their community, school or organizations.

Minimum requirements to be considered for induction are as follows:

- ✓ Youth bowlers and high school bowlers of Saint Lucie and Martin Counties. In order to qualify bowlers from both counties must be sanctioned by the USBC with an active smart account.
- ☑ Never suspended by USBC, ABC or WIBC
- Project an image that is respected and admired by bowling peers and serves as an example to our youth bowlers
- ☑ Be an upstanding citizen in the community

Additional qualifications to be considered for nomination are as follows:

- Provide a minimum of 100 hours of community service, school or organizations.
- ☑ Maintain at least a 2.5 GPA with a copy of your hight school transcript
- ☑ Actively applying to SMART account approved educational institutions
- Devote time and effort to promote bowling in general and help to increase participation in sanctioned competition in local, state and national levels
- ☑ Participate in state and local level tournaments.
- ☑ Demonstrate the ability to maintain a superior average
- ☑ Bowl a single game or three game series honor score that is recognized by USBC and is achieved in a sanctioned league.
- Points used for consideration for performance nomination must be accumulated in sanctioned leagues in Saint Lucie County and/or Martin County.
- ☑ Application must be sent no later than April 28th.

Nominator needs to include background of the nominee including high scores, ability and tournament titles pertaining to our enclosed point system.
